By: Charise Mericle Harper

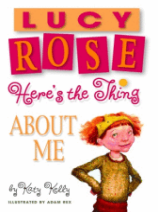

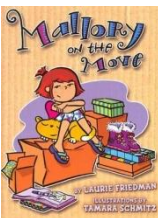
**Katie Kazoo Switcheroo Book 1: Anyone But Me** - Katie Carew wishes she could be anyone but herself, and turns into a hamster.

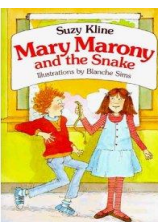

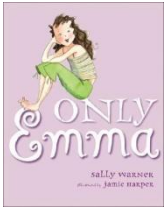
**Mary Marony Book 1: Mary Marony and the Snake** - With the support of her mother and new classmates, Mary sees a speech therapist about her stuttering problem.

By: Peggy Elizabeth Gifford

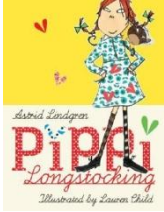

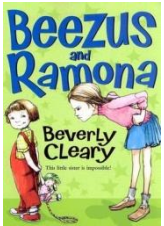

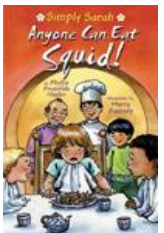
**Pippi Longstocking Book 1** - Escapades of a lucky little girl who lives with a horse and a monkey--but without any parents--at the edge of a Swedish village.
